



EV Charging Fee Begins July 1, 2025

For the last five years, the Utah Department of Government Operations (GovOps) has covered the operational costs of select state agency electric vehicle (EV) charging stations. Due to previous funding no longer being available, GovOps received authorization to begin charging a fee for the use of charging stations available at select state facilities beginning July 1, 2025.

\$1

Connection Fee

Users will be billed \$1.00 for connecting to the charging station.

8¢

Energy Fee

Users will be billed \$0.08 per kWh of energy used charging their vehicle.

25¢

Overstay Fee

Once the vehicle has finished charging, users will have 15 minutes to disconnect their vehicle and remove it from the stall. After this 15-minute grace period, users will be billed \$0.25/minute that their vehicle is still connected to the charging station.

What will the charging fee funds be used for?

Funds from the EV charging fee will be used to maintain the state facility EV charging infrastructure including a third party vendor, electricity costs, ongoing maintenance, and future replacement of the stations.
